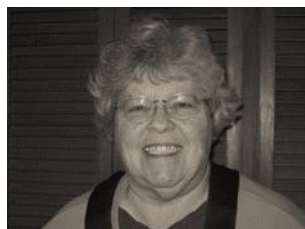

Questions and Answers

Several questions were received concerning the guidelines for praying the Liturgy of the Hours in Public. The following information is provided as clarification.

- "Public" refers to praying with others who are not in your Community as we do on retreats, days of recollection and other gatherings.
- The Invitatory Antiphon is not prayed between the stanzas of the Invitatory psalm. The Invitatory Antiphon is prayed the beginning and end of the Invitatory Psalm.
- The Psalm Prayer is not recited when the Hours are prayed in public.
- The Hours may be recited or chanted when prayed in public.
- The "Glory be" prayer is prayed by the entire assembly together.
